1. Interacting with the performance.
2. Learning how to behave in public with the public and older children happily taking responsibility for younger member of our school community.
3. Discussing and sharing thoughts and observations with each other.

#### **❖ Gifted and talented sessions with a mathematical focus in Years 4, 5 and 6**

#### **❖ Horse Riding for Pupils in Reception and Key Stage One.**
